This is a very scenic route. There are a few climbs identified on the map, but the route is rolling terrain as seen on the profile with many

short climbs, which is reflected in the overall amount of climbing. None of the climbs are extremely long, but some are short and steep.


The preferred direction is counter clockwise to avoid a steep climb into Williamsburg. Going down Radars Valley is the benefit of riding in this direction, but there is probably little significant difference in the riding direction.

The one thing that is lacking is access for water and food sources once you leave Lewisburg. There are no convenience stores on the route so plan accordingly. .

- 0.0 0.0 **START:** Greenbrier County Courthouse, Court Street, Lewisburg
- 4.4 4.4 **LEFT:** to continue on Co. 32, Fairview Road. Becomes narrow road with poor pavement.
- 6.6 2.2 **RIGHT** on Co. 19, Unus Road
- 11.0 4.4 **LEFT** on Co. 17. Williamsburg Road
- 11.8      Straight at intersection of Co. 17/2, Fort Donnally Road. Can be used to shorten route.
- 13.4 2.4 **LEFT** to continue on Co. 17, Williamsburg Rd. Going straight here is Option B.
- 15.6 2.2 **LEFT** on Co. 9 in Williamsburg.
- 15.7 0.1 **LEFT** on Co. 60/28 Raders Valley Road
- 18.2      STRAIGHT at intersection with Fort Donnally Road to continue on 60/28.
- 24.3 8.6 **LEFT** on U.S. Route 60
- 26.5 2.2 **LEFT** on 60/12 Sydenstricker Lane
- 28.9 2.4 **RIGHT** on U.S. 60
- 29.6 0.7 **LEFT** on Co. 60/11
- 29.8 0.2 **LEFT** on Co. 40
- 30.7      Hens Mill Covered Bridge
- 32.0 2.2 **LEFT** on Co. 33, Blue Sulphur Pike
- 32.6 0.5 **RIGHT** on Co. 33/2, Rich Valley Road
- 35.5 2.9 **RIGHT** on Co. 35 Houfnagle Road
- 36.0 0.5 **LEFT** on 60/13 Old Powell Road
- 37.8 1.8 **RIGHT** after next 90 degree left turn, it becomes South Court Steet. Follow Court Street to Courthouse.
- 38.6 0.8 **FINISH**



- 0.0 0.0 **Start:** Greenbrier County Courthouse, Court Street, Lewisburg
- 4.4 4.4 **LEFT** to continue on Co. 32. Fairview Rd. Becomes narrow road with poor pavement.
- 6.6 2.2 **RIGHT** on Co. 19, Unus Road
- 11.0 4.4 **LEFT** on Co. 17, Williamsburg Road
- 11.8      Straight at intersection of Co. 17/2, Fort Donnally Road. Can be used to shorten route.
- 13.4 2.4 **STRAIGHT** onto Co. 10. Co. 17, Williamsburg Road turns left.
- 14.8 1.4 Bare Left to continue on Co. 10
- 16.2 1.4 **LEFT** Sharp Left onto Co. 9
- 19.6 3.4 **LEFT** on Co. 60/28 Radars Valley Road. Refer to map.
- 28.3 8.7 **LEFT** on U.S. 60
- 30.5 2.2 **LEFT** on Co. 60/12, Sydenstricker Lane
- 32.9 2.4 **RIGHT** on U.S. 60
- 33.6 0.7 **LEFT** on Co. 60/11
- 33.6 0.2 **LEFT** on Co. 40 Will pass thru Hems Mill Covered Bridge on Co. 40.
- 35.8 2.2 **LEFT** on Co. 33
- 36.4 0.6 **RIGHT** on Co. 33/2
- 39.3 2.9 **RIGHT** on Co. 35
- 39.8 0.5 **LEFT** on Co. 60/13, Old Powell Road
- 41.6 1.8 **RIGHT** Road then makes an immediate left and becomes South Court Street.  
Follow Court Street back to start.
- 42.4 0.8 **FINISH**




This is a very scenic route. There are a few climbs identified on the map, but the route is rolling terrain as seen on the profile with many short climbs, which is reflected in the overall

amount of climbing. None of the climbs are extremely long, but some are short and steep.

The preferred direction is counter clockwise to avoid a steep climb into Williamsburg. Going down Radars Valley is the benefit of riding in this direction, but there is probably little significant difference in the riding direction. This option cuts out the Hems Mill covered bridge and some climbing.

The one thing that is lacking is access for water and food sources once you leave Lewisburg. There are no convenience stores on the route so plan accordingly. .

- 0.0** 0.0 **Start:** Greenbrier County Courthouse, Court Street, Lewisburg
- 4.4** 4.4 **LEFT** to continue on Co. 32. Fairview Rd. Becomes narrow road with poor pavement.
- 6.6** 2.2 **RIGHT** on Co. 19, Unus Road
- 11.0** 4.4 **LEFT** on Co. 17, Williamsburg Road
- 11.8**      Straight at intersection of Co. 17/2, Fort Donnally Road. Can be used to shorten route.
- 13.4** 2.4 **STRAIGHT** onto Co. 10. Co. 17, Williamsburg Road turns left.
- 14.8** 1.4 Bare Left to continue on Co. 10
- 16.2** 1.4 **LEFT** Sharp Left onto Co. 9
- 19.6** 3.4 **LEFT** on Co. 60/28 Radars Valley Road. Refer to map.
- 28.3** 8.7 **LEFT** on U.S. 60
- 30.5** 2.2 **LEFT** on Co. 60/12, Sydenstricker Lane
- 32.9** 2.4 **LEFT** on U.S. 60
- 34.2** 1.3 **RIGHT** on Co. 35
- 36.5** 2.3 **LEFT** to continue on 35
- 37.0** 0.5 **LEFT** on Co. 60/13, Old Powell Road
- 38.8** 1.8 **RIGHT** Road then makes an immediate left and becomes South Court Street.  
Follow Court Street back to start.
- 39.6** 0.8 **FINISH**
